## What we are learning in Reception Autumn Term 1: The Story of Me

Our focus this half term will be on developing children's positive sense of self and their understanding of their own place in the Ladysmith school community. We will spend time talking together and finding out about ourselves, our classmates and others. Through talk and stories, we will explore what it means to be a person, how our likes and dislikes make us unique and learn about how we can value and show love to others. We will start teaching children how to access the provision independently and the routines for the school day. Children will learn how to make positive behaviour choices, create positive interactions, and co-operate and resolve conflicts. We will find out about how to keep our bodies and minds healthy and safe, recognising the amazing things we can all do. We will use books, stories and videos to find out about people who live in different places and celebrate the diversity of our community and the wider world.

We are developing spatial reasoning through construction, play and problem solving activities.

We are learning our Set 1 single sounds and blending these with 'Fred talk' to hear, say and read words.

We are learning about the changes which occur in Autumn and will find out about seasonal food.



We are learning these poems by heart.



We will have an 'Apple Day' as the first of our '50 things to do at Ladysmith'.
