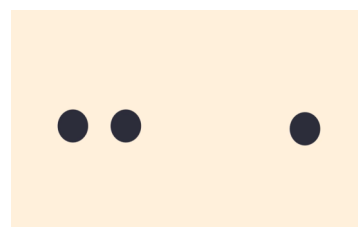
## What we are learning in Nursery during group time Spring Term 2:

This half term we will be learning to exploring dynamics (loud and quiet) and tempo (fast and slow) with Aurora orchestra. During skills week we will be learning how to join materials using treasury tags and split pins, making marks and patterns in clay, how to safely use the workbench to hammer nails and using the stage and resources. In maths we will be learning to compare quantities using the language more than and fewer than. We will learn the traditional story of the Gingerbread Man and spend time acting out stories with appropriate actions. We will also be planting seeds and caring for our outside plants. The ideas and skills that are taught during adult led group time are then embedded in continuous Provision in the following weeks.

These are the stories we will be focusing on this half term. There will be lots of other stories that we will be listening to and enjoying as well.



We are using Numbersense to develop our skills of subitising focusing on quantities within three in whatever way children see them, then drawing attention to ways that three can be partitioned into two parts, and finally using models to support visualising bonds to three.
