words and sentences. We

will be reading words with 4

or 5 sounds.

In Maths we will be learning about

such as odds and evens, doubles

We will be writing words by identifying sounds, writing these sounds with the letters we have learnt and forming these correctly. We will write short sentences, using finger spaces between words and a full stop to end the sentence.
