### Summer 1 in Reception: The World Around Us: Growth and Change

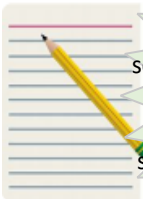
Isn't our world wonderful? This half-term we will be embracing the joy of Spring and Summer as we explore the changes in the natural world. We will care for plants and animals and learn about how they grow and change, learning what they need to thrive and how we can help to care for our planet and those we share it with. We will use stories, songs and videos to support our own observations and draw pictures, write and make digital recording about what we learn. We will go on nature walks and play outside, making observations, asking questions about the things we see and comparing this to the world in the autumn and winter.



In Maths we will be learning about the composition of numbers 6-9, comparing numbers to 10 and looking at patterns in numbers such as odds and evens, doubles and sharing.



We will be writing words by identifying sounds, writing these sounds with the letters we have learnt and forming these correctly. We will write short sentences, using finger spaces between words and a full stop to end the sentence.



We are learning our Set 1 single sounds and diagraphs ('Special friends') and blending these with 'Fred talk' to hear, say and read words and sentences. We will be reading words with 4 or 5 sounds.



We will listen to and learn new words from these stories, taken from our school book spine.
